

## DeSchrive Invitational 12-18-17

The boys recorded 17 PR performances on the night.

Jameson Woodell had three first place finishes – 55H with the fastest time on the night of 7.96. In the seldom run 600M he led a 1-2 finish for the Red Devils with a winning time of 1.29.36, with a charging Kristof Reid finishing in a time of 1.31.22. Jameson Woodell finished up the night with a first place finish in the High Jump, with a leap of 5' 10".

In the shot put Ethan Marshall had a PR throw of 42' 6 ½" with his teammate Benjamin Spearman throwing 41' 4" both athletes made the finals on the night.

On the girls side, they recorded 16 PR performances on the night.

On the track the girls had for athletes make finals in their respective events. Cheyenne Gurak in the 55H with a time of 9.48 in the finals, which was good enough for 6<sup>th</sup>. Nicolette Carvelli had 7<sup>th</sup> place finish running a 7.94 in the finals. In the shot put, we had two athletes in the finals Sadie Strober finishing 4<sup>th</sup> with a heave of 32' 9 ¾". Her team mate Samantha Reilly finished 5<sup>th</sup> with a PR throw of 29' 1 ¾".

Boys set 40 PR's during the meet.

David Bausmith set a new school record in the PV with a jump of 14' 7" which was also a meet record.

Ethan Marshall set a school record in the weight throw with a toss of 41' 7 ¼".

On the track the boys were led by Noah Ferraez with a solid 55M run in 6.94 and Alex Dale turned a solid split in the 4 X 200 recording a time of 23.6.

Girls set 31 PR's during the meet.

The top track performer was Brooke Riedy with a open 400M time of 61.28 and a split in the 4 X 200 of 26.8.

Sadie Strober led the field event effort with a personal best throw in the Shot Put of 32' 1 ½"
